University Park Campus (UPC) & Health Sciences Campus (HSC) Commuter and Housing Parking Online Sale	July 22nd at Noon

- **Summer Commuter Permits & Housing Permits** will be available for purchase online through your parking account.
- **Fall/Spring student** parking permits will be awarded through a **lottery process**. The Parking Lottery Process is simple and convenient since it takes place almost entirely online through your online Parking Account.

To get the Parking Permit that you want just follow these simple steps:

1. Create your Online Parking Account

If you do not have an existing account, please create an online Parking Account on the USC Transportation [website](http://transnet.usc.edu). Upon creating an account you will be requested to:

- **Select a classification.** It is important to select the right classification and/or housing residence as these selections will guide you to the appropriate parking choices
- **Select a USC housing residence.** If you are not living in USC housing choose N/A for this field. Eligibility for all off campus residential permits requires proof of residency for the location requested.
- **Add your mailing address.** This should be an address that your permit can be mailed to (continental U.S. mailing addresses only).
- **Add your vehicle information.**

2. Enter the Parking Lottery on Time

Make sure you don't miss the Parking Lottery Registration Period for your classification (i.e. UPC Housing Resident, HSC Commuters, etc.). Reminders for the Lottery Registration Period will be sent via email and advertised in the Daily Trojan. If you miss the Registration Period you will have to wait until after the Lottery is done; limited parking options may be available for purchase.

3. Add/Edit your Account Waitlists

During the Parking Lottery Registration Period, log into your online Parking Account and select your preferred parking lots by adding yourself to waitlists. Click on the "[Add or Edit Parking Waitlists](#)" link to add/edit your parking waitlists. You may choose up to 6 lots in descending order of preference. Customers are encouraged to add multiple lots to their waitlist to increase the chances of getting parking.

How to Add Waitlist Selections

1. Click on the "[your selection](#)" drop down menu and select the parking lot of your choice.
2. Click on the "[Select a Vehicle for your Permit](#)" check box.
3. Click on the "[Submit](#)" button.
4. Repeat the process up to 6 times or until you are satisfied with your selections.

**Please note you will not receive an email confirmation of your waitlist selections.

4. Wait for Parking Lottery Award Notification Emails

A few days after the Parking Lottery Registration Period closes, we will send out a notification email informing students of which permit was awarded. The permit will be charged on your USC Student Fee Bill account.

What to do if you've missed your Lottery Registration Period?

1. Create your Online Parking Account

If you do not have an existing account, please create an online Parking Account on our [website](#). Upon creating an account you will be requested to:

- **Select a classification.** It is important to select the right classification and/or housing residence as these selections will guide you to the appropriate parking choices
- **Select a USC housing residence.** If you are not living in USC housing choose N/A for this field. Eligibility for all off campus residential permits requires proof of residency for the location requested.

- **Add your mailing address.** This should be an address that your permit can be mailed to (continental U.S. mailing addresses only).
- **Add your vehicle information.**

2. Purchase a Permit Online

Once your Parking Account is set up you can purchase a parking permit for any remaining available lots. Simply choose your permit type and select your permit's start and end dates.

Term	Description
UPC	University Park Campus
HSC	Health Sciences Campus
Commuter	Any student driving to and from the University and not living in USC Housing
Off-campus Housing	USC Housing residences that are located outside of the campus' proper boundaries (visit www.usc.edu/map for exact locations)
On-campus Housing	USC Housing residences located on-campus or within the proper boundaries of the campus(visit www.usc.edu/map for exact locations)
Evening Permit	Parking Permits valid from 5pm to 7 am Monday – Sunday at any regular on-campus parking space including surface lots
Motorcycle Permit	Permits are valid in any on-campus 2-wheeled vehicle parking zone
Carpool Permit	Permits are valid in designated carpool-spaces 7am – 5pm.
Summer Gold	Permits are valid in all campus parking structures including PS1 and PS2 24/7 (not valid for parking in any off-campus lot at anytime)
UPC Parking Center	Permitted vehicles are allowed to park in the Parking Center 27/7; in addition in any available regular on-campus parking space including surface lots from 5pm-7am Mon-Fri, all day on weekends. Not valid for parking in off-campus lots at anytime.
