





USC Supplemental Safe Ride Program

Powered by Lyft

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Program resumes January 7
Nightly from 7pm to 2am

* Existing students that are already in the program, stay in the program. You do not need to re-register.

How does it work?

- New students will receive an email invite from Lyft on January 3
- 2. You may activate your current Lyft account or create a new account through this invite.
- 3. Any **Lyft Shared** ride inside the USC Safe Ride Program boundary between 7pm and 2am will be free.

How do I know if my ride is free?

- It will say USC Safe Rides in the promo section of the app.
- The quote fare box will say FREE after you enter your pick-up and drop-off locations.
- You will get a 0.00 receipt after your ride is completed.

A few other things to know:

- Free ride hours may change due to holidays, football games, etc. On these days, the USC Transportation website (usc.edu/transportation) will be updated with service hours.
- Please do not share your invite with anyone. Invites are unique and once they are activated they will not work again.
- You must select Shared from the ride options. A Lyft Shared ride is 1–2 passengers so you may bring one other person on your free ride. Please ignore any fee shown on the app for an extra person, your credits will cover this cost.
- Access to campus is limited from 8pm and Lyft will not be able to enter for pick-up or drop-off. If you want to get picked up on campus, please call Campus Cruiser at 213.740.4911
